# Fowey & Desborough

#### 1. Introduction:

In October 2020 the Leisure and Amenities Committee discussed parking issues in Fowey and Desborough. A resident suggested that planting on the grass verges would stop vehicles from parking their vehicles there.

It was resolved that the Parish Office work with Freshbrook Parish Councillors to draft a local survey to better ascertain residents preferences for a solution.

## 2. Local survey feedback:

A survey was posted on the West Swindon Parish Council Website, and a letter delivered to all residents in Fowey, Desborough inviting them to take part in the survey.

13 residents completed the survey. 6 residents lived in Fowey and 7 from Desborough.

- 4 households have 3 vehicles
- 6 households have 2 vehicles
- 3 households have 1 vehicle
- 7 households park on their drive way
- 3 households park on the road
- 2 households park On the road, On a verge, In another street near by
- 1 household parks On their drive way and on the road
- 4 households don't think that there is a problem with parking in these areas
- 3 households felt that parking was causing Obstructions to driveways and junctions, Creating poor visibility for other drivers.
- 6 households felt that problems were caused by Parking on verges, damaging grass or planting, Obstructions to driveways and junctions, Creating poor visibility for other drivers
- 2 households would like to see restrictions in place to prevent parking on verges and open spaces
- 8 households are not in favour of restrictions to prevent parking on verges and open spaces
- 3 households are unsure if they would like restrictions in place
- 8 households would like to see the verges enabled for parking
- 5 households are not in favour of verges being enabled for parking
- 12 households think that action should be taken
- 1 household doesn't think that action needs to be taken

- 4 households believe that residents can find a solution the parking issue themselves
- 8 households do not think that residents can find a solution to the parking issue themselves
- 1 household is unsure
