Highways Safety Measures – Hay Lane

1. Background

- 1.1 Swindon Borough Council is the Highways Authority. The Parish Council has a number of highways related powers including the
 - Power to repair and maintain public footpaths and bridleways
 - Power to light roads and public places
 - Power to provide parking places
 - Power to provide traffic signs
- 1.2 In September, Swindon Borough Council completed a Stage Two consultation on potential traffic regulation order restrictions being imposed on Hay Lane and Tregoze Way.
- 1.3 Cllr Sydney Smith has requested that the Parish Council consider supporting the introduction of signage to highlight children/pedestrian crossing in this area.
- 1.4 To erect a warning or regulatory sign on a new sign post generally costs between £235 and £410 dependent on size. Site surveys and relevant permissions would also need to be sought.

2. Financial Implications:

The Parish Council has no budget allocated for highways-related works.

3. Recommendations:

3.1 That Councillors note this report and instruct the Parish Manager on any next steps to be undertaken.
