212. Apologies & Applications for Dispensation

Apologies received from Cllrs Dayan, Gattapur, Grother, Llewellyn, and Swinyard. Declarations of Interest required by the Code of Conduct adopted by the Parish Council on 20 May 2024: none

213. Road Sweeping Update

Councillors received a verbal update from the Parish Manager outlining that contract documentation was being finalised with Idverde to establish up to three road sweeping rounds across the Parish. It was anticipated that work would commence in April. Publicity would be promoted to ask residents to keep roads free.

214. Projects Update

Councillors received a report summarising progress to date on a range of projects, a copy of which appears as **Appendix A** in the Minute Book.

- ATB Youth Engagement
 - A Friday evening session from $4.30~\rm pm$ to $6.30~\rm pm$ is arranged with a start date of $25^{\rm th}$ April and running through to the Autumn.
- Street art murals

The Toothill Bodiam Drive mural is completed. The feedback has been positive. The artist simplified the design due to the size of the subway. Work is underway on the Bodiam Drive subway and should be completed shortly. Brookfield subway will then get started.

- It was agreed that there should be media releases to promote the individual murals and it was noted that an art trail poster/booklet was planned for Easter.
- Hay Lane hedgerow planting

The team have completed clearing out dead vegetation along the Hay Lane hedgerow and have replanted over 300 hornbeam whips.

- Litter pick board/Great British Spring Clean
 The Litter Pick board feedback has been positive to date and no vandalism or theft to report. Cllr Gattapur had requested the board for Westlea Park. It will continue to be monitored.
- Play Update
 Ground conditions to delay the completion of replacement play work at Whitehill Park. It was hoped that it would get installed before the Easter holiday.
