Formed in 2017 with 15 Parish Councillors, West Swindon Parish Council provides a range of services across West Swindon. The team inspect and repair 20 play areas, cut 990 km² of grass, and trim back 70 kilometres of hedgerow and 67 km² of shrub bed. We also empty around 200 public bins and collect litter and flytipping every week.

The successful person will be a hands on person who is not afraid of getting involved in all aspects of the work. We will support you to use a wide range of tools and machinery including working with a tractor. You will be able to work on your own and as part of a team.
